GOVERNOR IGNORES ENERGY CRISIS

I'm incredibly frustrated over Governor Hobbs' lack of care, concern, and action with skyrocketing power bills detrimentally impacting residents living in the San Carlos Irrigation Project. My constituents in Florence and Coolidge are being taken advantage of by the federally owned company, managed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, who in August began imposing unreasonable and drastic rate hikes on customers for electricity by more than 250% in a single month! Sen. Kerr, Rep. Griffin, Rep. Martinez and I sent a letter to Hobbs on October 3rd requesting she advocate for these residents by fulfilling her duty to push back against the Biden Administration and find solutions to cut these costs. She has so far ignored us. As a direct result of her inaction, these citizens, many of which are living on fixed incomes, are facing the tough reality of not being able to keep their power on.





RACIST KATE HOBBS PUSHES WOKE PROPAGANDA

Instead of focusing on real issues hurting Arizona citizens, like soaring inflation and an energy crisis, Katie Hobbs is attempting to once again appeal to the radical left by pushing woke, divisive and racist propaganda on to our public employees. She created the "Diversity, Equity, Inclusion & Accessibility Council." The work of this Council will likely come into direct conflict with my recently enacted state law prohibiting this state, or any of its agencies, from using public monies for any sort of training that presents blame or judgment on the basis of race, ethnicity or sex, which is a foundational concept of diversity, equity and inclusion theory. Her effort is an obvious cover for her racist past of not only nominating an antisemitic to lead the Registrar of Contractors, but also for her wrongful firing of a black state employee that ended up costing Arizona taxpayers hundreds of thousands of dollars in damages.
