The Arizona Freedom Caucus and Legislative Republicans made this possible with a portion of the \$2 billion surplus in the last budget we passed. Unfortunately, but not surprising, Katie Hobbs and ADOR violated the law when they directed recipients to the governor's website for more information. Katie Hobbs didn't want to provide this relief for families and fought us on it. As a result, our legislation explicitly prohibited her office from taking any credit for it. Her self-serving political stunt on the taxpayers' dime prompted our attorneys to send a cease and desist letter to ADOR laying out the costly consequences of breaking the law. I look forward to the Joint Legislative Psychiatric Hospital Review Council meetings this fall and am eager to share what I've learned about the shortcomings in Arizona's health care system — and the importance of these three key interventions. SUPPORTING OUR HEALTH CARE WORKFORCE

Thank you to the Arizona Association of Nurse Anesthesiology for honoring Senator Shope and I for our legislative efforts on workforce development. Increasing access to quality care without jeopardizing patient safety is of the utmost importance to us, as well as our colleagues in the Senate Republican Caucus. Last session, I allocated funds in our state budget for a grant that will establish the Student Registered Nurse Anesthetist Clinical Rotation Program to expand the capacity of preceptor training programs for nurse anesthetists. I also sponsored a new law that establishes stricter requirements for dental anesthesia for dental offices. As a registered nurse, I will always be committed to supporting our health care workforce and its patients. I believe there is a lot that can be done to improve results and overall experiences for everyone and will continue my efforts into next session.
