GOVERNOR MAKES AN UNLAWFUL POWER GRAB

This week, she sent me a letter saying she was withdrawing her remaining nominees from consideration by the Senate. Bingo Technological Aids (BTAs) have been lawful in Arizona since 2017. They're a substitute for bingo cards and accommodate individuals with disabilities, in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. The Departments of Revenue, Gaming, and Liquor are all threatening to criminally prosecute these nonprofits and revoke their liquor licenses because they're using BTAs. I have a hunch this harassment is due to influence of the tribal gaming industry who wants monopoly over all gaming. I sent a public records request to these agencies to get to the bottom of this issue, and I hope to come to a resolution soon.
